The California Governor's Office of Land Use and Climate Innovation (LCI) invites Tribal leaders, representatives, and Tribal community staff to join a virtual information session on the SB 18 Tribal Consultation Guidelines & Toolkit update and the Planning Tribal Advisory Group (PTAG). This virtual information session will explain upcoming opportunities to participate, including government-to-government consultation, the PTAG nomination process, and how these efforts connect to the General Plan Guidelines (GPG) and Specific Plan Guidelines (SPG) updates.

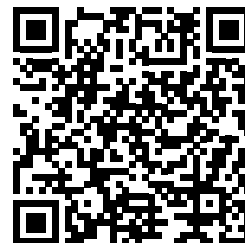
